## When you complete the PLP & Individual Needs section of an IEP You Should Be able to State:

- The students unique needs that require the student educational program to be individualized
- What the student can and cannot do in each area of identified need.
- The strengths of the student upon which you can build.
- The areas of concern the parents have raised about their child's needs.
- The environmental and human or material resources the student will need to enable him/her to benefit from education.
