



## When you complete the PLP & Individual Needs section of an IEP You Should Be able to State:

- The students unique **needs** that require the student educational program to be individualized
- What the student can and cannot do in each area of **identified need**.
- The **strengths** of the student upon which you can build.
- The areas of **concern the parents** have raised about their child's needs.
- The environmental and human or material **resources** the student will need to enable him/her **to benefit from education**.
